Panel: Policy/Government Officials

Topic: Local Government: Understanding Challenges and Opportunities Moderator: Tim Shamblin (President, BRAR Board)

Description: Regions across the U.S. are facing significant stressors to their housing supply—rising costs, gentrification in some areas and disinvestment in others, and shifting policies at every level of government. Join local government representatives as a panel explores the most innovative ideas to overcome obstacles and shape the future of local housing.

Panel: National Coalition for the Homeless

Topic: The Faces of Homelessness

Description: The "Faces of Homelessness" Speakers' Bureau is comprised of extraordinary people who are committed to sharing their personal and powerful experiences of homelessness with others. From homeless activists to riveting poets, all have found a unique way for their voices to be heard.

Panel: Evictions Discussion/Experts

Topic: Knowledge Lab: Eviction laws, their role in the pandemic and the resources available for help

Description: An overview of new eviction laws in Virginia and comprehensive update on resources to keep families in their homes. DHCD will explain programs to help families and landlords apply for rental assistance.

Topic: Statewide Housing Study and Impact of COVID-19 on Housing Providers

Description: This session will explore housing data and the effect COVID-19 and how that might impact policy decisions in the future.

Description: Three women discuss their struggles with finding affordable housing. An open and honest conversation from a mom who raised her kids in a motel room and a new homeowner who struggled with homelessness. This session will take a look at their barriers to finding housing and solutions to make it better.

Description: Join an interactive feedback and discussion session on the term NIMBY, how to talk about it, and how to overcome it.

These recommendations will be discussed as potential regional solutions as well as their applicability to other communities in the region.
